**English Language Laboratory in Rural Background:** 

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The language laboratory is an audio or audio-visual installation used as an aid in modern language teaching. They can be found, amongst other places, in schools, universities, and academies. Perhaps the first lab was at the University of Grenoble in 1908. In the 1950s up until the 1990s, they were tape-based systems using reel to reel or (latterly) cassette. Current installations are generally multimedia PCs. The original language labs are now very outdated. They allowed a teacher to listen to and manage student audio via a hard-wired analogue tape deck based systems with 'sound booths' in fixed locations.

### Objectives of Language Lab in Spoken English:

The objectives of the Language Lab are-

### **Nature of Language Lab in Our College:**

The College has purchased language learning software from **Biyani Technologies Kolhapur**. It is known as **ACE Digital Language Lab**. It is a unique State of Art solution developed to improve communication of all level of students by concentrating on basic language learning skills i.e. Listen, Speak, Read and Write (LSRW). It helps to improve oral as well as written skills of student. It teaches how English can be used in day-to-day activities.

Using the lab; student can improve the command over their language, gain confidence and get ready for real world challenges like facing interviews, doing presentations, expressing thoughts, etc. Digital Language Lab involves students to actively participate in language learning exercises and get more practice than otherwise possible in a traditional classroom environment. The software comes with complimentary study material for self practice, assignments, audio, video presentations and clippings, etc.

Language Lab is a fully furnished room equipped with all the necessary tools and instruments. It has two cabins in which one cabin is meant for teacher and other for students. The first monitoring cabin operates the entire students through controlling motherboard.

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Second cabin has seventeen computers connected to controlling motherboard. In the language lab the text, video and audio are integrated. The purpose or the language lab is to actively involve the students in the learning process of English.

#### **Teacher Console / Administrative Console:**

Teacher Console is the control panel for monitoring the student consoles. Students get the pre-recorded lessons from the Teacher console after logging into their consoles. Teacher can broadcast to all the students, monitoring and communicating with each student is also possible without disturbing other fellow students.

### **Student / Learner Console:**

In the student console, the student has the facility of listening, speaking, repeating, comparing and writing (typing) the lessons assigned in the class by the teacher. The students can log into the teacher's console by typing in their name and number. Students will be getting the pre-recorded lessons from the teacher console after logging in. Student can call and communicate with the teacher from the student console without disturbing others.

### **Functioning of Console:**

In the student console, the student has the facility of listening, speaking, repeating, comparing and writing (typing) the lessons assigned in the class by the teacher. The students can log into the teacher's console by typing in their name and number. Students will be getting the pre-recorded lessons from the teacher console after logging in. Student can call and communicate with the teacher from the student console without disturbing others.

The levels of functionality of current language labs vary from manufacturer to manufacturer. All labs will have a level of teacher control to manage student licenses / desktops. The more sophisticated 'software only' labs have a higher level of teacher management and control over the student desktop. One of the key differences with the 'high end' 'software only' products is their ability to work 'live' with the students as they record and work with media. So instead of waiting to correct student recordings after they have been recorded and collected back it is now possible for a teacher to work synchronously and 'live' with students on their own, in pairs and in groups, thus enhancing the immediacy of the teaching and learning experience.
